Thou Shall Not

- ◆ Access, upload, download, or distribute pornographic, obscene, or sexually explicit material.



Thou Shall Not

- ◆ Transmit obscene, abusive, sexually explicit, or threatening language



Thou Shall Not

- ◆ Violate any local, state, or federal statute



Thou Shall Not

- ◆ Access another individual's materials, information, or files without permission



Thou Shall Not

- ◆ Violate copyright or otherwise use the intellectual property of another individual or organization without permission.



Thou Shall Not

- ◆ Use another person's password



Thou Shall Not

- ◆ Vandalize, as defined as unauthorized access or attempt to damage computer hardware/software or networks, or destroy the data of another user, including create, upload, or intentionally introduce a virus.



Thou Shall Not

- ◆ Intentionally waste limited resources.



Thou Shall Not

- ◆ Use the school network for commercial purposes.



Thou Shall Not

- ◆ Harass,
insult, or
attack others.



Thou Shall Not

- ◆ Use, disclose, or disseminate personal information online such as full name, home address, phone number, etc., except with approval by school staff



Thou Shall Not

- ◆ Use e-mail lists from the district's Internet site, network, or servers to create mailing lists for non-school purposes.



Thou Shall Not

- ◆ Gain unauthorized access to resources or entities.



Thou Shall Not

- ◆ Invade the privacy of individuals



Thou Shall Not

- ◆ Improperly alter the setup of computers (desktops, icons, wallpapers, screensavers, installed software) as determined by the network administrator



Thou Shall Not

- ◆ Use software that has not been assigned or approved by the staff.



Thou Shall Not

- ◆ Fail to follow a district policy while using computers or failing to follow any other policies or guidelines established by district administration, teachers, or other staff



Thou Shall Not

- ◆ Seek to gain unauthorized access to information resources or other computing devices
